- A. **Andy Krogh on behalf of the MAC:** Shirts: New woman's style with scalloped neck and the 2 button rule.
- B. **Judy Sharp:** For safety reasons I would like to propose modifying the current rule of wearing a "belt or half belts" in section 3.1 Clothing and Tack in the CGA Rule Book to "the option of wearing a belt or half belt" especially during the Hurry Scurry event. The new section would read "All contestants shall be fully attired in a dress shirt with a button or snap closure in the front from top to bottom, a collar, long or short sleeves (female contestants may wear sleeveless shirts), long pants, and boots. A option of wearing a belt or half belt is encouraged, but not required."
- C. **Lea deMontigny:** Change of Hurry Scurry jumps, she will bring examples to convention.

- B. **Geri Azavedo:** Novice match races to be for 12/under only
- C. **Lisa Bradley:** I would like to propose that the order of age groups in each respective division is reversed each year at state show. Example: This year (2013) the ages groups ran youngest to oldest in their respective divisions. So, in 2014, the order would be reversed so that the older age groups would run first in their respective divisions. 2015 youngest to oldest, 2016 oldest to youngest and so on. This proposal allows a fair way so each age group has a chance to ride earlier in the day and to possibly have better ground. This proposal would not affect the pony divisions.
- D. **Dianna Malley:** Propose that districts cannot charge more than \$3.50 per Time Only or Setup event at any show.
- E. **Dianna Malley:** Propose to change the shape of the flags for Figure 8 Flags, would like to see them in the shape of a pennant rather than square, will bring example to convention.
- F. **Lea deMontigny:** Section 6-3-1 ROC Champion and Reserve Champion: Would like to remove the AAA rating from this program. The awards in the program is based on average not a rating so the AAA rating should not apply.
- G. **Lea deMontigny:** 6-3-7 All Around Champion: This award program is based on the placing by points not by if you are rated AAA.
- H. **Lea deMontigny:** 7.1 Senior Elite Program: Propose to change the age from 45 to 55.
- I. **Lea deMontigny:** 7.1 to 7.3 .8 would like to remove all the hall of fame. There were members that were going to come up with a new name but has not yet. So if there is no name then remove the words of hall of fame.
