The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Q - what is the true call when a riders hat comes off in the arena, Either before the timers or after the timers?

A - The correct answer is found in the Rule Book - Section 3.1 a Clothing and Tack. If a hat falls off while on course it is a one second penalty.

The only head wear allowed to be worn while in the arena are helmets and cowboy hats. If a rider enters the arena with a ball cap, beanie or visor - they get a one second penalty.

If an adults' helmet falls off - they get a one second penalty.
If someone under 18 has a helmet fall off - it is a No Time.

ATTENTION ALL RIDERS AND JUDGES RULES CHANGES AS OF CONVENTION 2009

RB section 5.1b
Display Scoreboards - may not have the running time displayed

RB section 7.4
Strike the word painted from description of barrels.
Add "unaltered" to the description of barrels.
Allow barrel covers to be used.

RB section 6.14
add section 6.14 h CGA judged have the option to be on inactive status for up to one year (with current membership) when they request the status with the State Office or their Master Judge. If they are inactive for over one year, they must judge with an active judge until they are "up to speed" and then seek approval from their Master Judge for reinstatement to active status. After one year of expired CGA membership, judges lose status and if they want to become a judge again, they must start the process over.

RB section 3.1 a
clarification of the consequences for riders under 18 not following the helmet rule. If a rider under 18 is mounted is mounted on a horse without a helmet they will be asked to dismount until properly attired and a warning will be issued. If a rider under 18 enters the arena without a helmet correctly worn they will be disqualified from the event. If a rider under 18 has more than one helmet violation on the same day, they will be disqualified from the show.

RB section 5.11
clarification of the consequences for members who violate the drug or alcohol rule. Anyone who has been seen violating or willfully admits to violation of the drug & alcohol rule when questioned shall be notified by a judge that they are banned from further participation in the show for the rest of the day.

RB section 4.3
add a final sentence to the paragraph that shall read "By starting the course the rider accepts the course, as long as the course is legal."

RB section 2.3
Lead Line wording change - both in the heading and first sentence shall read "Special Lead Line rules for riders who need assistance / The CGA is interested in providing an opportunity for riders who need assistance to participate in CGA shows.

RB section 4.1
Add section 4.1 f "Re-Rides: The only time a rider will be required to rerun an event is if the timers malfunction or a course is improperly set. If a rider has successfully completed a legal course and then it is determined there was a problem (for instance the ground is/was unsafe or there was some sort of interference) the affected riders will be given the option for a re-ride."

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$120.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$120.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
