Hello CGA,

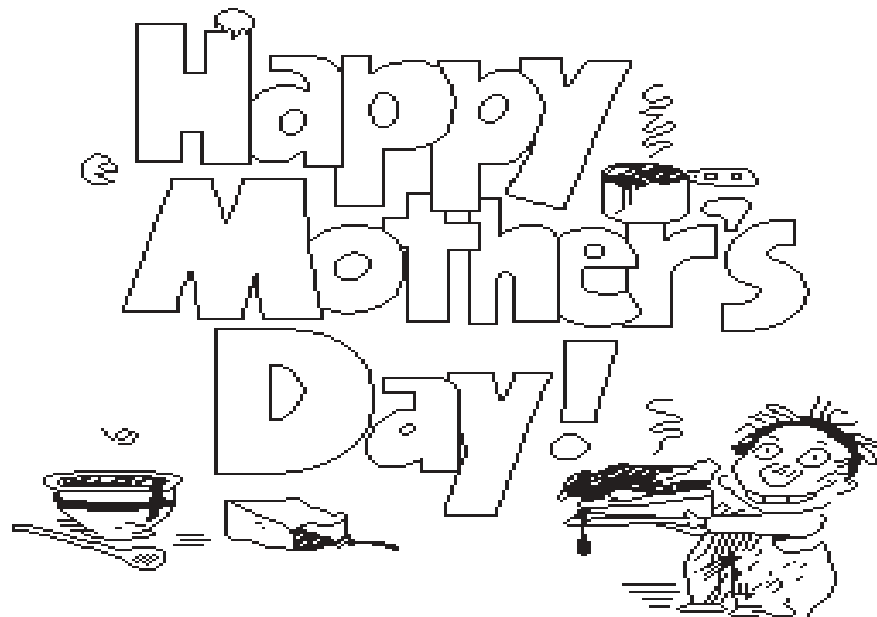
Time to start getting the horses in shape for Classic's there right around the corner. Don't forget you need to either be rated FC or have riddend a minimum of 15 rides on any combination of horses for state show this year, sothe Classics are a great way to get rated for State Show. With the high fuel costs, you can get all your rides at one place. Classic entries must be postmarked by May 11 to avoid a late fee so mail them in early. Remember Classics are a state sponsored show so state rules apply and the districts hosting these shows are doing it so everyone can ride and will need help working these shows. It's up to you, riders if these shows take place each year and these shows are what help fund things for CGA and keep your costs down for awards and convention. Everyone needs to volunteer and help at the shows at least one event.

DISTRICTS, You must turn on your computers before your next show date to make sure your software has not expired. You must do this Monday through Friday, **STATE OFFICE is NOT OPEN** on the weekends and **YOU WILL NOT** be able to get your key code to use your software. You will be doing your show **BY HAND!** It has been posted in the paper the last two months and **IF** you had a **DELEGATE** at the Board of Directors meeting you would know this. **IF** you did not now you know why you should have a delegate at the meeting. This is not something new you had to do the same thing last year. It is **YOUR** responsibility to call and get the code during the week. There is no exception to this state office will not be answering the phone on the weekends and you cannot get the code from anyone else but state office. Your software warns you when it is going to expire so there is no reason for you not to get the code before it expires and before your show weekend. You have to have your computer on and be at it when you call state office. It takes a matter of 1 minute to get this taken care of. **Do NOT CALL** Phyllis on her home number or on her cell phone. She has to be at the computer also in order to give you the code.

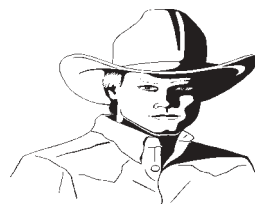

The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

If anyone has questions concerning this ruling you may contact the Rules Chairman, Andy Krogh 760-505-8241andy@kroghwelding.com.

Question: Can a rider with a cast on one arm rider Hurry Scurry?

Answer: Yes. So long as the rider can maintain balance, show control of the horse and is safe, then they can ride in any event.

Question: A riders horse becomes unable to compete and has a vet note, can they transfer their points to a new mount for yearend awards?

Answer: There are two situations here, one state level and one local level.

State: There are no points for State Awards. There are times based of a specific Horse/Rider Combo. A rider needs so many times to qualify for the award they signed up for. Those times cannot be transferred to a new mount. The fees paid to state may be transferred to a new mount, but in essence you are starting over with the new Horse/Rider Combo.

Local: There are no State rules as to how a club makes up their points and does their yearend awards. It is up to the district to develop their own policies in this situation. The district's Board of Directors would have to determine how they would like to deal with their own points and yearend awards situations.

Senior Elite Awards Program

The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions).

The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite Hall of Fame. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite Hall of Fame. They will receive a special Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle and a framed picture at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix. If the rider does not also receive an Senior Elite Champion or Reserve Champion jacket, they have the option of receiving a Senior Elite Hall of Fame jacket instead of the Hall of Fame buckle.

Senior Elite Champion In Each Event

The riders with the 1st and 2nd best average times in the event are the SE Champion and SE Reserve Champion, respectively. SE Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an SE jacket listing each event in which they are Champion or Reserve Champion.

Senior Elite Top Five Riders

The CGA's Senior Elite Top Five Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 5 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows:

1st - 11 points	2nd - 9 points	3rd - 8 points
4th - 7 points	5th - 6 points	

Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the Five riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Five. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Five Riders must have a SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Five buckle.

Registration and Fees

The SE registration fee is \$120.00, which includes the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame award, but not the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite Rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Level 1 award.

Senior Elite riders may sign up for Level 1 and Level 2 awards for a fee of \$140.00. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame awards and the Level 2 award. A Senior Elite rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive both the Level 1 award and the Level 2 award. Fees are not refundable.

CGA STATE SHOW QUEEN AND COURT - 2011

If you are a CGA member between the ages of 14 and 19 as of January 1, 2011 and have been a member in good standing for at least two consecutive years, you are eligible to be chosen as the new reigning Queen of CGA or one of the Princesses for the 2011-12 Season

Your entry must be postmarked by June 1, 2011. CGA is not responsible for late arrivals. There is an Open Book Quiz that you must complete and send to the CGA Office.

All winners will be notified by mail and will
LEAD THE GRAND ENTRY AT THE STATE SHOW.

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
