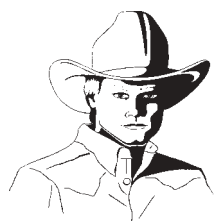

The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Question: Can I wear a jacket or sweater over my clothes to stay warm?

Answer: Yes you can wear a jacket or sweater over your clothes. A judge may ask to see you to verify that you are in correct CGA apparel (RB 3.1). Also the only Items allowed to be worn on the head when riding are Helmets and Western Hats....No Beanies or Visors.

*****ATTENTION ALL CGA MEMBERS*****

Please make sure the spelling of your name on your membership card is correct. The CGA software is very name sensitive and incorrect spelling could result in your rides not being credited to you. Also yearend awards are printed with the same spelling as appears on your membership cards.

Family Team Award

CGA is a Family organization and in recognition of the many families that ride together in CGA we offer a Family Team Award available to all riders regardless of ability.

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$120.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$120.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Sign up today so that your family doesn't lose any rides. This is a fun award to earn and a great way to enjoy gymkhana with your family.

CGA STATE SHOW QUEEN AND COURT - 2013

If you are a CGA member between the ages of 14 and 19 as of January 1, 2013 and have been a member in good standing for at least two consecutive years, you are eligible to be chosen as the new reigning Queen of CGA or one of the Princesses for the 2013-2014 Season

Your entry must be postmarked by June 1, 2013. CGA is not responsible for late arrivals. There is an Open Book Quiz that you must complete and send to the CGA Office.

All winners will be notified by mail and will **LEAD THE GRAND ENTRY AT THE STATE SHOW.**

The Queen and Court are representatives at all CGA State functions and will receive a sash and a Silver Buckle. The Queen will receive a Silver Buckle, a silver hat tiara at the State Championship Finals 2013 and a rhinestone tiara at Convention 2013.

Check with your family. Make sure you are can attend the State show & Convention, send in your entry early, and GOOD LUCK to you!

QUALIFICATIONS FOR QUEEN AND COURT

- Must be between 14 - 19 years old as of January 1, 2013
- Must be a CGA member in good standing for at least 2 full, consecutive years as of January 1, 2013
- Must pass an open book quiz of CGA information

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF THE QUEEN AND COURT

- To give out awards at the CGA State Championship Show 2013,
- Give out Year End Awards at Convention 2013
- Southern or Northern Spring Classics 2014
- To ride in the Grand Entry at the State Show 2013 on a well groomed horse/pony
- Demonstrate good Sportsmanship at all times
- To be a role model during any CGA functions
- Wear Appropriate Attire, Be Respectful to Others, Smile

What is it they said, "Build it and they will come" or something like that? I don't remember building anything but they sure do keep coming. Phyllis, at the state office, has confirmed that as far as average number of riders is concerned District 27 is the largest CGA District in California. Now before you Sunny Southern California districts get all bent out of shape, yes we know you run lots more shows than we do, but we sure do get the riders.

Our first 4 shows averaged 110 riders and the shows are running so late we finally had to bite the bullet and agree to start earlier. We've always run at 10 to 10:15 partly because so many of our riders come a long way and partly because we just hate getting up so blooming early. Starting with our February 9 show we will be signing up at 8 and starting the first event by 9:15. We're having great success with our on line sign up where you can fill out all your forms on line, print them, take a picture with your smart phone and email it to the show secretary. She can enter all those people on Friday before the show cutting down on the time it takes to enter riders into the computer. Thank you to all you riders who are taking advantage of this. It saves you time too, cause on Saturday morning you can take your check to an express line and not have to stand in line to sign up.

We've made another change too. We've had numerous requests to do a two day week end show and will be doing that the final two shows of our season, April 13 and 14. Senior Elite Awards Program

The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions).

The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite Hall of Fame. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite Hall of Fame. They will receive a special Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix. If the rider does not also receive an Senior Elite Champion or Reserve Champion jacket, they have the option of receiving a Senior Elite Hall of Fame jacket instead of the Hall of Fame buckle.

Senior Elite Champion In Each Event

The riders with the 1st and 2nd best average times in the event are the SE Champion and SE Reserve Champion, respectively. SE Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an SE jacket listing each event in which they are Champion or Reserve Champion.

Senior Elite Top Ten Riders

The CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 10 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows:

1st - 11 points	2nd - 9 points	3rd - 8 points	4th - 7 points
5th - 6 points	6th - 5 points	7th - 4 points	8th - 3 points
9th - 2 points	10th - 1 point		

Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the Five riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Five. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Ten Riders must have a SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Ten buckle of jacket.

Registration and Fees

The SE registration fee is \$120.00, which includes the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame award, but not the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite Rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Level 1 award.

Senior Elite riders may sign up for Level 1 and Level 2 awards for a fee of \$140.00. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame awards and the Level 2 award. A Senior Elite rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive both the Level 1 award and the Level 2 award. Fees are not refundable.

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
